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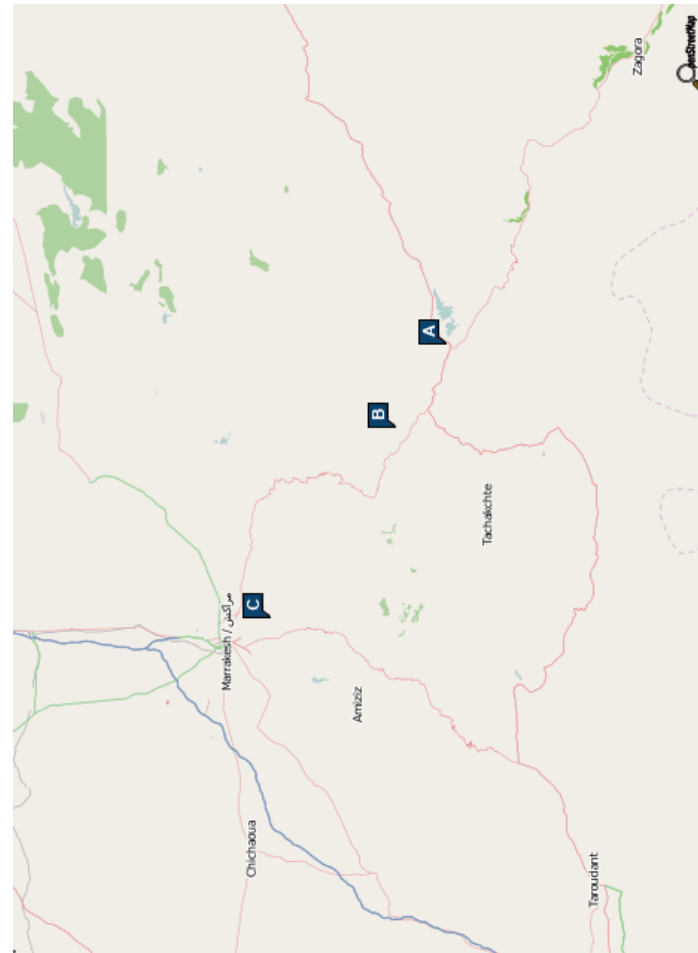

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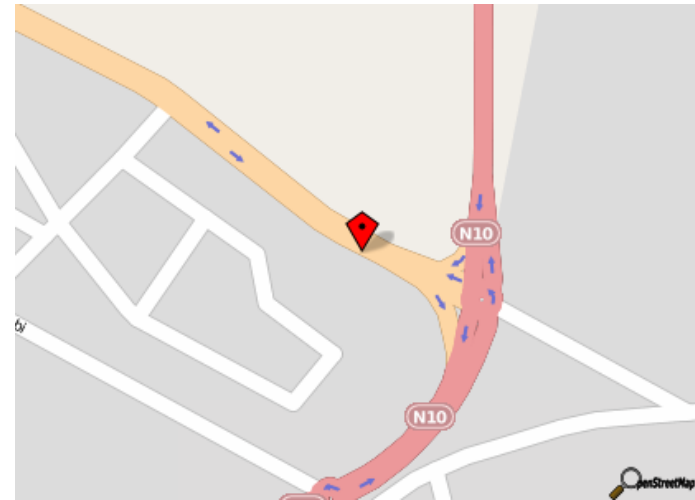

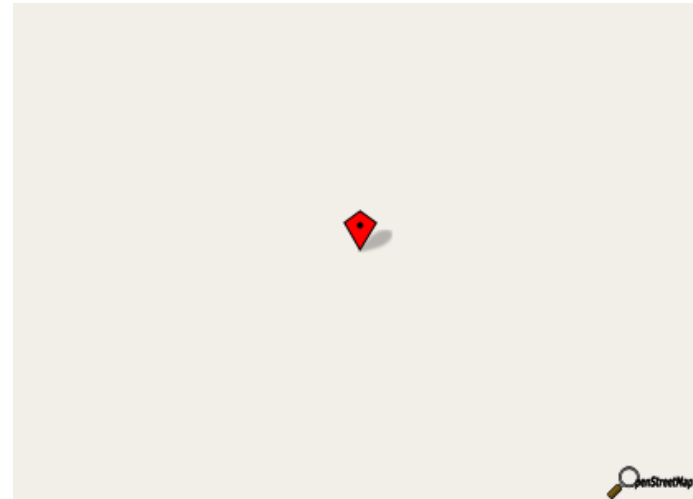

Boumalne Dadès at the foot of the Gorges is a lively market center. The Dadès canyon is known for fascinating rock formations and the gigantic Kasbahs of which most, however, cannot be seen. They lie on the right and on the left the small rivulet Dadès, mostly on rock outcrops. Hotel Kasbah Tizzarouine in Boumalne offers comfortable accommodation and nice meals as does the Hotel Chez Pierre in the canyon.

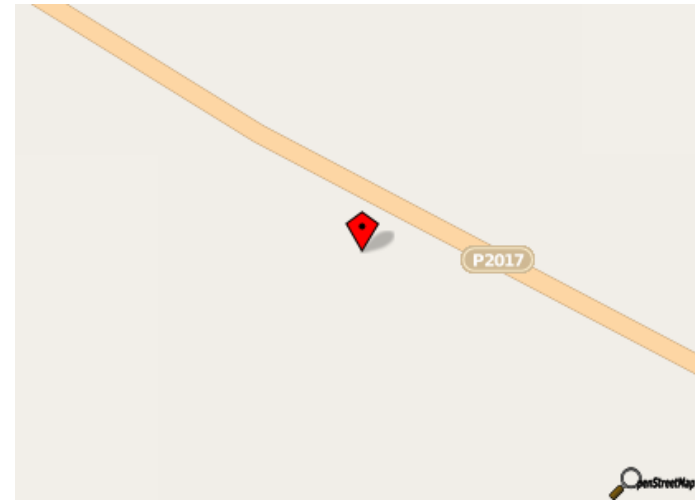

C Gorges du Todhra

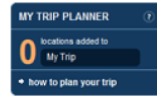
This marvelous canyon is located at the east exit of Tinghir. On the right and on the left of the Todhra, there are clay villages which look as if one had stuck them to the rocks. The people here have a point when they claim the Todhra to be the most beautiful oasis of the country. The further you go up the canyon, the narrower it gets, at the back end you feel like you're going to break through the rocks. Shepherds push their goats along the rocks and climbers hang on the walls high above.

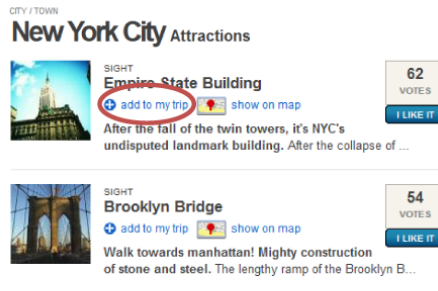

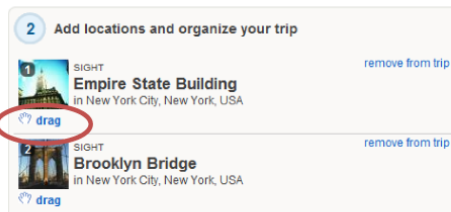

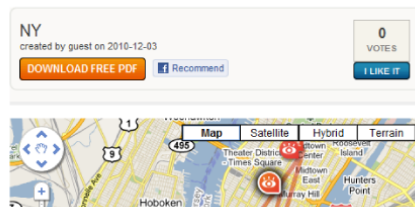
- 2 **Plan and organize your trip:**
